HANDGUN INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION

Course Description:

This 44 hour, Colorado POST-approved **Handgun Instructor Certification** course is designed to provide law enforcement officers the necessary skill and knowledge to develop and operate a law enforcement firearms/handgun program for their agency and/or assist teaching handgun skills in a police academy setting.

Course Requirements:

- Students will be required to pass the Colorado POST Handgun Qualification Course on day one of training (two attempts).
- Failure to pass the qualification will result in removal from the course.
- Students must be a current sworn Law Enforcement Officer.



Outline:

Students will learn how to develop and maintain a firearms program, manage and operate firearms ranges, instruct handgun skills, and diagnose shooting errors and make sustainable corrections in other shooters. Students will develop the ability to instruct the following:

- appropriate set up and accessories for the handgun
- weapons maintenance
- fundamentals of shooting
- “combat” shooting techniques
- use of various positions and cover
- efficient weapons manipulations
- malfunction clearances
- understanding wound ballistics
- tactics and techniques for fighting with the handgun
- extended range shooting
- low light / night techniques.



Students should expect a fast paced and physically active learning environment that will include running, kneeling and quickly assuming various unique shooting positions.

Student Must Provide:

- Duty Handgun w 3 magazines
- Duty belt / holster
- 1000 rds handgun ammo
- Ballistic vest (optional)
- Laptop Computer*
- 5 dummy rounds
- Hat, ear protection, eye protection (both sunglasses and clear eye pro)
- Flashlight
- Weapons mounted light (optional)

Instructors:

The training staff is comprised of individuals who have a wealth of experience as instructor trainers and utilizing these weapons in real world situations; from police patrol duty and police special weapons teams, to military Special Operations conducted in the War on Terrorism.

*all classroom materials will be provided on a computer thumb drive. Students will need a lap top computer to view the materials
