SWAT FIREARMS DRILL



Pre-requisites:

- Students must be sworn Law Enforcement Officer
- Completed carbine / patrol rifle operator certification
- Completed basic SWAT course

Course Description:

This 16 hour SWAT Firearms Drills course is designed to provide law enforcement tactical teams the necessary skill and knowledge to respond to complex and rapidly evolving deadly force situations. Training will focus heavily on students operating in two to four person teams while engaging single to multiple targets in a complex and dynamic environment. Training will stress weapons skills using a gas masks, in low light situations, while utilizing protective shields and breaching equipment.

Course Learning Objectives:

- Advanced Handgun Skills
- Advanced Carbine Skills
- Understanding Wound Ballistics
- Multiple Target Engagements
- Target Identification and Fratricide Avoidance
- Team Movement and Weapons Handling
- Weapons Skills Wearing Gas Mask
- Low Light Considerations
- Specialty Tools Considerations

The training staff is comprised of individuals who have a wealth of experience as instructor trainers and utilizing these weapons in real world situations; from police patrol duty and police special weapons teams, to military Special Operations conducted in the War on Terrorism.

Students should expect a fast paced and physically active learning environment that will include running, kneeling and quickly assuming various unique shooting positions.

Student Must Provide:

- Carbine w/ tactical sling
- Handgun / holster
- Tactical Kit / Vest / Helmet
- Gas Mask
- 800 rounds carbine ammunition 200
- rounds frangible carbine ammo 600
- rounds handgun ammo
- Ear protection, eye protection

- 3 (or more) magazines Flashlight
- Notebook and pen

- Team Equipment: Breaching tools Shields
- Tactical Vehicle
