



SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER FIREARMS SKILLS



Pre-requisites: Student must be a sworn Law Enforcement Officer
Completed carbine/patrol rifle operator certification

Course Description:

This 16 hour School Resource Officer Firearms Skills course is designed to provide school resource officers the necessary skill and knowledge to respond to complex and confusing deadly force situations within a public school setting. Students will be exposed to various use of force options appropriate to the rapidly evolving situation. Training will stress positive target identification, understanding of what a firearm will and will not do to immediately stop and adversary, developing necessary firearms accuracy in tight and crowded environments, and single officer response tactics.

Course Learning Objectives:

- Advanced Handgun Skills
- Advanced Carbine Skills
- Understanding Wound Ballistics
- Multiple Target Engagements
- Target Identification and Fratricide Avoidance
- Single Officer Response Tactics

Instructors: The training staff is comprised of individuals who have a wealth of experience as instructor trainers and utilizing these weapons in real world situations; from police patrol duty and police special weapons teams, to military Special Operations conducted in the War on Terrorism.

Students should expect a fast paced and physically active learning environment that will include running, kneeling and quickly assuming various unique shooting positions.

Student Must Provide:

- Carbine w/ tactical sling
- Duty belt / holster / handgun
- 400 rounds carbine ammunition
- Tactical vest (optional)
- 100 rounds frangible carbine ammo
- Shooting mat (optional)
- 400 rounds handgun ammo
- Binoculars or spotting scope
- 5 dummy rounds
- Hat, ear protection, eye protection (sunglasses & clear eye pro)
- 3 (or more) magazines
- Flashlight
- Weapons mounted light
- Notebook and pen
